Abstract

This study aimed to determine the acceptability of sweet potato gravy in terms of its appearance, texture, aroma, consistency and taste. The researchers sought qualified and competent evaluators of the three mixtures (A,B,C) whose output was further tested by 50 conveniently selected students of John B. Lacson Foundation Maritime University Molo, Inc. during the first semester of school year 2016-2017. The researchers made use of sensory test to observe the characteristics of the sweet potato gravy and used an evaluation checklist for its acceptability. The statistical tools used were mean and standard deviation. The study revealed that the sweet potato gravy was "completely acceptable" among selected students of JBLFMU-Molo for this particular semester only.
