**Abstract**

The study was undertaken to determine the acceptability level of jackfruit seed cookies among the students of bachelor of Science in Cruise Ship management of John B. Larson Foundation maritime University Molo-Inc.

The respondents of the study were 12 males and 18 females from the Bachelor of Science in Cruise Ship Management students.

The researchers used the descriptive type of study and simple random method to measure the acceptability of jackfruit seed cookies. Checklists were given to the respondents for the assessment of the study. The data were subjected to t-test for independent samples interpreting the results at alpha level of 0.05.

Result of the study showed that the aroma, taste, texture, appearance and general acceptability of jackfruit seed cookies are at the "acceptable levels", when respondents were grouped according to sex and year level, and when taken as an entire group.
