Abstract

The purpose of this descriptive study was to determine the Effects of Covid-19 on Hospitality Industry as Perceived by Future Seafarers. The respondents of this study were the 86 randomly selected third year BS Cruise Ship Management students of John B. Lacson Foundation Maritime University - Molo, Inc. enrolled in the first semester of the Academic Year 2020-2021. The data needed for this study were obtained through the use of a checklist made by the researchers and was validated by experts in the field, t-test was used to find out the significant difference existing in two variables. The variables were sex which was categorized as male and female and age. The results revealed that Covid-19 has an "extreme effect" on hospitality industry as perceived by future seafarers when taken as a whole. When taken according to sex, results showed "extreme effect" for both male and female. In terms of age, Covid-19 has an "extreme effect" for ages 20 years old and below and 21 years old and above. It was also found out that there is no significant difference in the effects of Covid-19
