## **Abstract**

This study determined the experiences of BSCSM (Bachelor of Science in Cruise Ship Management) among Fourth year CSM students of JBLFMU-MOLO, S.Y. 2016-2017. The respondents of this study were 151 randomly selected BSCSM 4th year students. The respondents are categorized according to sex, section, and type of restaurant. The instrument used in gathering of the data in this study was the researcher-made questionnaire. The statistical tools used in this study were frequency, percentage, mode, t-test. Results show the experiences of the BSCSM 4th year students of JBLFMU-Molo in their Practicum 1 was FAVORABLE. No significant differences were noted in the experiences of the students in their Practicum 1 as to sex, section, and type of restaurant. The top-most favorable experiences of the students in their experience were that: their Practicum experiences had helped them maximize their skills, challenged, and made them confident as future professionals. However, their top-most difficulty encountered during the OJT were gender inequality, bullying, and maltreatment.
