ABSTRACT

BACKGROUND OF THE STUDY



The proposed framework, based on the cognitive information processing model, the sociocultural perspective, and the PASS cognitive processing model, organizes previous research in terms of the cognitive consequences of common online activities. From a cognitive-developmental perspective, the Internet is a cultural tool that influences cognitive processes and an environmental stimulus that contributes to the formation of specific cognitive architecture.

The Internet is an integral part of most college students with more than 90 percent of the college students in United States have access to the Internet. Addiction to the Internet and online social network sites can affect a student's academic performance both positively and negatively. Controlled use of the Internet can have positive influence on student's academic performance. College students influence of the Internet usage, Facebook usage, online media usage, polychronicity and student's interest in university on their academic performance and face-to-face communication skills is studied. Eight scales, that include Internet usage, Facebook usage, online media use for education, online media use for non-education, polychronicity, student interest in university, academic performance and face-to-face communication are measured. Structural equation modeling is used to evaluate the hypotheses. Findings indicate student interest in university significantly influences academic performance. Additionally Internet usage and student interest in university significantly predict face-to-face Communication.

Cognates are found in departments of a number of other names, including departments of "Internet and Society", "virtual society", "digital culture", "new media" or "convergent media", various "iSchools", or programs like "Media in Transition" at MIT. <u>Lamos. S. (2013)</u> stated that On the research side, Internet studies intersects with studies of cyberculture, human-computer interaction, and science and technology studies.

The Internet has introduced improvements in technology, communication and online entertainment, but it is also incredibly useful for education purposes as well. Teachers use the Internet to supplement their lessons, and a number of prestigious universities have opened up free online lectures and courses to everyone. It has even allowed retired teachers to read to and educate children in poorer countries. Widespread use of the Internet has opened up a substantial amount of knowledge to a much broader range of people than ever before by *Dow, M. J., Lakin, J. M., & Court, S. C. (2015).*

According to <u>Klenke, A. (2016)</u> teachers can make use of the Internet by giving students extra resources and material from the Internet, such as interactive lessons and educational games. Many college courses use a "hybrid" model where many lessons are done online, requiring fewer in-class meetings. This saves students from having to commute to campus with their heavy textbooks every day. Tests, homework, collaboration with students and research can all be done from any computer with Internet access. Even for non-hybrid classes, the Internet is used as an addition to normal studies.

Internet Seen as Positive Influence on Education but Negative on Morality in Emerging and Developing Nations

<u>Nelson, J. (2016)</u> reveals Internet Usage More Common Among the Young, Well-Educated and English Speakers As more people around the world gain access to all the tools of the digital age, the internet will play a greater role in everyday life. And so far, people in emerging and developing nations say that the increasing use of the internet has been a good influence in the realms of education, personal relationships and the economy. But despite all the benefits of these new technologies, on balance people are more likely to say that the internet is a negative rather than a positive influence on morality, and they are divided about its effect on politics.

<u>Small, R. V., Snyder, J., & Parker, K. (2017)</u> says that overall, a median of 64% across 32 emerging and developing nations say the internet is a good influence on

education, with at least half also seeing it as a good influence on personal relationships (53%) and the economy (52%). People are more mixed on the internet's effect on politics, with similar proportions saying that the influence is good (36%) as say it is bad (30%).

Publics in emerging and developing nations are more convinced that the internet is having a negative effect on morality. A median of 42% say it is a bad influence on morality, while only 29% see the internet as a good influence. And in no country surveyed does a majority say that the internet's influence on morality is a positive.

However, many in these emerging and developing nations are left out of the internet revolution entirely. A median of less than half across the 32 countries surveyed use the internet at least occasionally, through either smartphones or other devices, though usage rates vary considerably. Computer ownership also varies, from as little as 3% in Uganda to 78% in Russia says <u>Todd, R. J., & Gordon, C. A. (2017).</u>

CHAPTER 3

Methodology

This chapter presents the method of research utilized in this study, the research design, respondents of the study, data gathering instruments, data gathering procedure, together with the data gathering processing techniques. Instrument

Statements such as: "I am updated of the news and happenings of my place because of the Internet Center, "It makes my vocabulary more richer", "I learned different facts and figures", "It is very accessible when there are rush submission of projects", "I discover ideas and things on my own because of the references at the library", and "The Internet Center is a time of study in my subjects, especially the difficult ones" are also the top benefits of the Internet Center to the Educational Development of the students.

Both variable and antecedent have the same impact that could affect the Educational Development of the students.

All of the benefits/ importance are highly affecting to the students which means that the Internet Center is totally significant towards the Educational Development of the students. And look for possible ways in order to make it more useful and beneficial to the students.

RECOMMENDATION

In accordance in the studies' findings and conclusions that the Internet Center is a great help to the students in accomplishing tasks, learning, enjoying, informing of the students, the researchers aims for more and greater empowerment of the student's educational development, the researchers highly recommends:

 That the school must help improve and support the Internet Center and its facilities by maintaining it and buying the necessary equipments for it to be operated well.

2. The school must demand many researches and thesis writing for the students to maximize the uses of the Internet Center.

3. The Rules and Regulations of the IC may be more strict and implemented very well, for the students to use the IC in good ways.

4. That there will be less technical problems in the IC and be more accessible to the students.
