*Abstract*

This descriptive survey research aimed at determining the JBLFMU students' reasons for using the internet had 333 respondents who are students of the university. A researcher-prepared questionnaire was used to gather data. Frequency counts, percentages, and Cramer's V were used as statistical tools. The findings of the study revealed that the respondents had different top 3 reasons for using the internet when they were taken as a whole group or when grouped as to course, sex, year level and place of residence. There is no significant relationship between the sex, course, year level and location of residence of the respondents and their reasons for using the internet.
