Abstract

This study determined the Food and Beverage (F & B) Practicum 1 and its contribution to BSCSM Fourth Year Students of the College of Business, JBLFMU-Molo, Iloilo City.

The research design used in this study was quantitative-descriptive. The respondents of this study were the 100 fourth year BSCSM students. Frequency count, percentage, and mean were used as descriptive statistics and the t-test for independent samples for two-tailed tests was used as inferential statistics. Results reveal the following: (1) The level of Practicum among the fourth year students was "very high" as an entire group and when classified according to different categories such as sex and residence; (2)

The contributions of the F & B are the following: "the practicum is very important for us in the Hospitality", "the practicum contributes to develop us", "the Practicum The Practicum 1 subject is a valuable experience", "the practicum makes us transfer our knowledge;" (3) No significant differences were noted in the contribution of F & B when it comes to sex and residence. This means that the classification of students according to male or female does not influence their F & B Practicum contribution also with those students who lived in urban and rural areas.
