Abstract

This study determined preferred careers of fourth year BS Tourism students of JBLFMU-Molo, Inc. The respondents of this study were the 51 selected students of fourth Year BS Tourism. This study focused on the preferred careers of graduating Lacsonian BS Tourism students. The independent variables were sex, sibling rank and monthly family income. The dependent variables were the preferred careers of BS Tourism students. The statistical tools were frequency count and percentage. Results revealed that the highest preferred careers of fourth year BS Tourism students of JBLFMU-Molo were airline flight attendant, owner/incorporator of travel agencies, hotels, resorts or other lodging accommodations and restaurant, field sales representative, airport ground crew, staff on the department of tourism and other tourism-oriented institutions, tour coordinator and counter sales representative.
